

# Homework Code

- **ALL Students are supposed to do their homework as soon as possible after class.** And review them before next class to get ready for the quiz. Turn it in with the quiz and staple them together, homework on the top.
- NO late homework accepted.
- You need to **fill out the circles and outline your solutions and key steps in your separated solution sheets.** Otherwise, the homework will be considered incomplete. (That is to say, making selections only and leaving shorthand notes are not enough.) On the top of your homework sheets, you need to print your FULL NAME, write your section number and indicate if you have attempted anything for Extra Credit.
- Students need to complete their homework independently. Discussions are definitely allowed and encouraged. One student may even show his/her homework to others to explain the details. However, no one is supposed to write down any thing while you are looking at other's homework. (Notes excluded.)
- All students are required to do their homework **with enough endeavors.** Unsatisfactory homework will catch the instructor's eye, and he will talk with you and your advisor in person to resolve this issue. Successive failures to meet this standard will hurt your quiz score.
- You need to successfully complete one whole Extra Credit question in exchange for 1 extra credit point in your quizzes (**1 question, 1 point**). (There could be more than one Extra Credit question.) If the questions are partially answered or the basic homework questions are not answered satisfactorily, no point will be given. You need to indicate beside your name that you have attempted Extra Credit problems or have left comments. Otherwise, your earnest work or word may be overlooked and you lose the extra points you deserve.
- The special group of two students should write out your work as clearly as possible. You two should actively contact the instructor to perfect your solutions. Others are welcome to ask for help too! You two are expected to give almost perfect answer as well as to attempt the Extra Credit problems. The extra points that could add to the next quiz are UNLIMITED for the two students.
- Other than the two appointed by the instructor, the instructor will randomly grade 3-8 copies each time. Satisfactory work (including significant improvement from previous works) will be given extra points in the quiz. (Extra Credit questions are not necessary in this case.) Other copies of homework will be examined by the instructor. Exceptional and below-the-standard work will all be noticed and recorded.
