MyMathLab General Information

MyMathLab is an online Learning Management System that includes your text, course assignments, and Learning Catalytics (clicker or Personal Response System). All will be accessed online through MyMathLab. **You will register for My Math Lab through your Lab Section site in Canvas.** Please see "MML Student Registration Handout" for instructions on how to register through your Lab section site in Canvas.

You will take Quizzes and Tests using MyMathLab during your Lab Classes. You will also work on Homework and Practice material through MyMathLab. Lecture class attendance quizzes may also be given through MyMathLab using Learning Catalytics.

You will need to purchase an access code, or pay for access online, for MyMathLab associated with our textbook **Algebra and Trigonometry**, **10th Edition, by Michael Sullivan**. Those of you waiting for Financial Aid or need to defer payment may sign up for Temporary Access. If you initially sign up for temporary access, you will have a 2-week grace period in which you will be able to use the online resources. **Payment or an access code must be entered into the website to continue your access after the grace period is over. There will be no extensions for students not purchasing the access before the grace period is over. Missed assignments, quizzes, and tests because access was not purchased will be unexcused**.

You MUST memorize your username and password for MyMathLab so that you can login to MyMathLab directly rather than going through Canvas. Please use your FSUID (abc18d) as your username and FSU email as your email. When you first login to MyMathLab, you will be asked to enter your Student ID. Enter your FSUID (abc18d), i.e. the ID you use to login to Canvas. This is how YOUR grades will be credited to YOU, so it is critical that you put in this ID.

You MUST enroll in your MyMathLab site using your Canvas section (Lab Class) site. If you change sections during drop/add, you must enroll in MyMathLab through your new section (Lab Class) site in Canvas. You only need to pay for access once; you will not need to pay for access again if you change lab sections.
